

RACE FOR YOUR FLAG

The GT Global Championship is the world championship where countries are represented. **GT4 is the Nations Grid: one entry is one nation**, and every car is crewed by **two or three drivers sharing the flag** — because every round is a **6-hour race**, real endurance racing with real seat time. When a country reserves its national entry, drivers from the network slot into funded crew seats, and the crew's result scores for the flag on the Nations Trophy. In a category where prize money barely exists, **every car in the points here leaves with a check**.

WHAT THE NETWORK GIVES YOU

- **A route to funded seats.** When a nation reserves its entry, network drivers get the call — matched by nationality first, capability always. Nation-backed drives, not pay-drives.
- **A ladder inside one paddock.** Friday's open running and the Saturday GT4 exhibition sprint put new drivers on track before a flag seat — and GT4 crew seats develop into GT3 seats with the championship's teams.
- **A no-touch series.** Contact is priced in championship points and clean driving is publicly ranked — your car, your budget, and your reputation are protected by the rulebook itself.
- **A season documentary and world feed built to make drivers famous** — the sponsor value that pays careers. Every flag needs drivers: dual nationals and emerging racing nations especially wanted.

THE STRAIGHT ANSWERS

Does joining cost anything? No. The network is free to register — a talent pool, not a program you buy.

Who qualifies? GT4-capable drivers holding a national racing license — Am and Silver especially. Every nationality.

Who pays for the seat? National partners fund country entries; drivers of a nation may also take arrive-and-drive crew seats inside their own nation's entry. Network drivers are placed, not charged.

When? The first green flag flies in 2027, at Road Atlanta. The network is forming now — placement follows the flags as nations sign, in calendar order.
